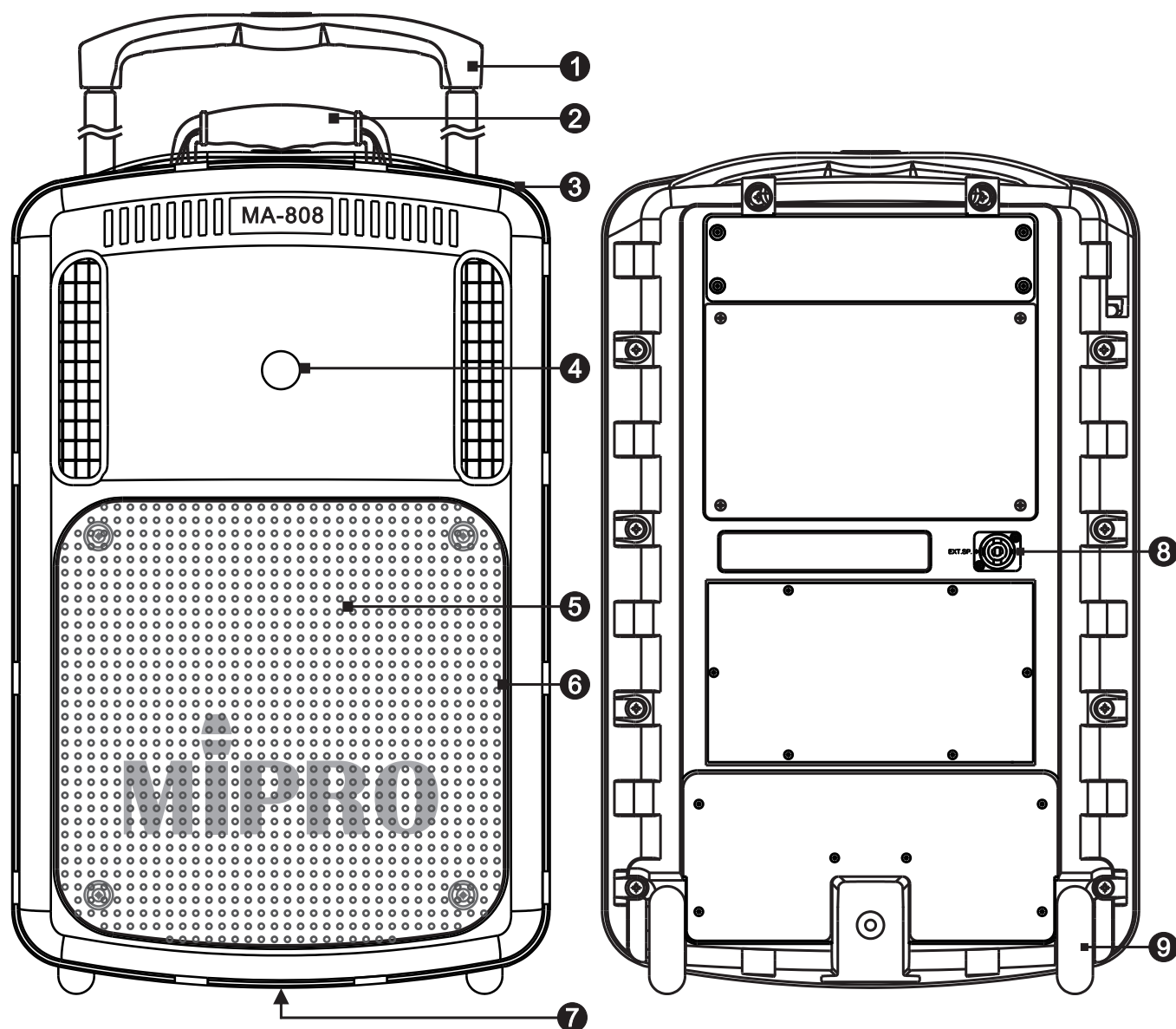

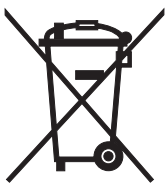

II. Helpful Operating Tips

1. Retractable Handle: Push the handle upward from the space on the rear center to retrieve retractable handle. Push downward to store the retractable handle.
2. Fixed Carry Handle: For balanced, easy hand carrying.
3. Microphone Storage Compartment: A handy storage compartment for your handheld or bodypack transmitters.
4. Tripod ⑦ : There is a tripod mating socket mounted in the base of the MA-808 to accommodate a 35 Ø tripod stand.
5. Passive Extension Speaker input Socket: Accepts output from the Passive Extension Speaker Socket of MA-808.
6. The MA-808EXP passive extension speaker has compression driver 50 watts /8Ω and woofer 150 watts /4Ω speakers. Do not allow the speaker cables to short and touch metal parts as it could damage the system amplifier.
7. Refer to the actual product in the event of product description discrepancy.
